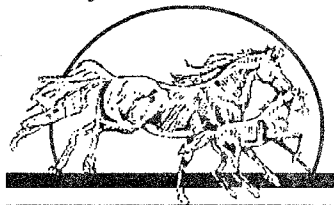

ADMINISTERING HOMEOPATHIC REMEDIES

Homeopathic remedies are potentized microdilutions of substances such as herbs.

The horse must not have food or water in its mouth for at least 5 minutes before to 5 minutes after you give the remedy.

This allows the remedy to be absorbed from the oral mucosa. Only a small amount in the mouth is necessary. One small squirt with the bottle, trying to avoid contaminating the tip of the bottle with the horse's saliva, is sufficient. Keep the remedy out of bright sunlight and at room temperature.
